SENTENCE

1. Have considered the able mitigation for the accused. That he is a first offender. That he is remorseful, a husband and a father of 7 children. That there was a fight between him and the deceased which resulted in the death the subject of this case.
2. I have considered the long remand period that the accused has had since 2013. I have also considered the victim impact assessment report dated 25/10/18. He has also recently sat for his KCPE while in prison showing a positive attitude towards rehabilitation.
3. Taking into consideration all the foregoing, I sentence the accused to probation 1 year. Right of Appeal 14 days explained.
