**RULING ON BAIL**

1. The accused person faces a charge of murder contrary to **section 203** as read with **section 204** of the **Penal Code**.
2. Having taken into account that bail is not opposed I will grant the accused person application on the following terms:
  - (a) The Accused may be released on a cash bail of KShs.100,000/=.
  - (b) In the alternative the accused may be released on a bond of KShs.500,000/= with one surety of same amount.
  - (c) The accused is warned not to approach, whether directly or through proxy potential witnesses in this case, or to intimidate, threaten or confront any of them in any way.
  - (d) If any of the above terms are proved to have been breached the accused is warned that he stands to have his bail cancelled.
