**RULING ON SENTENCE**

The accused have been convicted of the murder of EVANS OKEROSI MOKORA which took place on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2018 at Nyagenke Village, Kenyena Sub County within Kisii County.

The accused were out to avenge the assault of the 3<sup>rd</sup> accused's father by the deceased. They chased him dragged him out of the house he was hiding and set upon him with pangas.

I have considered that they are first offenders, seek leniency and that they are young and should be given an opportunity to reform.

I sentence, EVANS SHEM OSORO, ROBERT MASEA GEDION and DENNIS OINO ONDABU to **twenty (20) years** imprisonment each. They are informed of their right of appeal.
