S E N T E N C E

1. **JAFETH WASONGA OLUNGA** was charged with the murder of **SAMUEL OLUOCH OMONDI**. The particulars of the offense were that on 3rd September, 2014 at Malunya Village, Alego East Sub-Location of Migori County, he murdered the deceased. He has now pleaded guilty to the lesser offence of Manslaughter.

2. I had the opportunity of hearing 6 witnesses who testified as to the circumstances of the offences. He came to the deceased home drunk and stabbed him after demanding 20/= which the deceased owed him.

3. He has stated that he has a wife and two children. I have noted from the evidence that he is an alcoholic hence a non-custodial sentence would not be suitable.

4. I sentence him to four (4) years imprisonment. Such term to take into account the time he has been in remand.
