**RULING**

1. I have considered the notice motion dated 17.7.2025 the supporting affidavit sworn on even date by Evans Juma Matunda and the annexures attached thereto and I do note from the affidavit of service sworn on 30<sup>th</sup> July 2025 by Silvia A.
