RULING

1. The applicant was charged and after a full trial convicted for the offence of grievous harm contrary to section 234 of the *Penal Code*. He was sentenced to serve life imprisonment.
2. The applicant filed the present application dated 23rd June 2025 seeking sentence review. The grounds raised are that the sentence imposed should be revised and to consider the time spent in remand .
3. I have considered the application, the grounds in support and the applicable law. From the record of the trial court, the court considered the applicant’s mitigation, the time spent in remand custody and the fact that the applicant was a first offender before sentencing. Having considered the application in its totality and the aggravating circumstances of the case, the sentence imposed was legal.
4. In my view of the foregoing, I find no good cause or reason to revise the sentence imposed by the trial court. The application dismissed for lacking in merit.
