RULING

1. This is a ruling on an application for rectification of grant on the basis that the estate is partially distributed.
2. That the administrator died on 5th December, 2016. The two beneficiaries died and their sons may receive their share allocation.
3. I had allowed the applicant to furnish the court with better details and the applicant filed a supplementary affidavit on 2nd February, 2025.
4. I further direct filing of written submissions which the applicant failed to comply.
5. I have considered the summons for rectification of grant dated 19th May, 2025 and find the same to be without merit.
6. No proof of death is evidenced and no reason at all is offered with regards to failure to share the share to Isaac Mwangi Mbugua to only one son and not the other.
7. I further note of inclusion of Beatrice Wambui Mbugua whose inclusion is unexplained.

I thus dismiss this application.
