**RULING**

1. The applicant Margaret Jepkoech Serem filed application dated 28<sup>th</sup> July 2025 through counsel Chepkilot, Kiptoo & Co. Advocates seeking to have her mother Jenifer Kobilo Tuitoek adjudged as suffering from mental disorder pursuant to section 26 of the *Mental Health Act* Cap 248 Laws of Kenya.
2. She urged this court to appoint her as guardian ad Litem manage the subject’s affairs, proper and bank accounts. The court directed her to avail the subject together with her other siblings.
3. Upon perusal of the Chief’s letter dated 6<sup>th</sup> November 2024, I note that the Chief confirms that the subject has memory loss and that she has 3 daughters the applicant being one of them.
4. The subject’s other 2 daughters attended court and confirmed that hey have no objection to the applicant Margaret Jepkoech Serem being appointed as guardian Ad Litem to manage the estate of the subject who is their mother.
5. I have also perused medical report dated 7<sup>th</sup> November 2024 from Baringo County Referral Hospital and it confirms that the subject has stress disorder, memory loss and poor self-care.
6. In view of the above, I find the application herein merited and proceed to allow. Margare Jepkoech Serem is hereby appointed as guardian Ad Litem to the estate of the subject Jeniffer Kobilo Tuitoek.
