**JUDGEMENT**

1. For the court's determination is the Applicant's Notice of Motion dated 24<sup>th</sup> June for orders as hereunder;-

**1. That judgement be entered in favour of the Applicant against the Respondent for the sum of Kenya Shillings One Hundred and Seven Thousand and Forty (Kshs. 107,040/=) only being the certified costs due to the Applicant as against the Respondent.(sic)**

**2. That the Respondent does pay to the Applicant the costs of the Application together with interest on the fixed sum.**

2. The Application is supported by grounds set out on the body thereof as well as affidavit evidence of Njoki Kinyua Advocate. In a nutshell, the Applicant's Law Firm claims the stated sum on the basis of an Advocate-Client Bill of Costs dated 12<sup>th</sup> March 2024 the Deputy Registrar of this court taxed on 13<sup>th</sup> June 2025.
3. Return of service of the Application upon the Respondent is filed but no reply has been made. The Application is therefore deemed as unopposed and hereby allowed as prayed.
4. The same situation obtains in **Miscellaneous Civil Application No. E290 of 2024** between the same parties. Similar orders issue in that Application.
5. Judgement accordingly.
