JUDGMENT

1. In her unopposed Petition dated 1st August 2023 the Petitioner seeks orders that:-
 - (a) The marriage celebrated between the Petitioner and the Respondent on or about 13th October 2010 be deemed dissolved.
 - (b) The divorce/dissolution issued on 4th December 2013 by the Ganserndorf District Court, Division 6 Ganserndorf in Austria be re sealed and upheld as an order of this court and the divorce of the marriage be registered in Kenya.
2. The petition is supported by the grounds thereof and the affidavit by the Petitioner sworn on the same date.
3. As stated above the petition which is brought under Section 22 and 61 of the *Marriage Act* is not opposed. It shows that the Petitioner and the Respondent married each other at the Marriage Registry Nakuru on 4th October 2010 and moved to Austria.
4. Their marriage did not last long and they did enter into a formal consent to divorce each other which the court in Austria endorsed it on 4th December 2013.
5. In view of the above provisions of the Act this court has no option but to allow the petition. There was no opposition from the Respondent.



6. The petition is hereby allowed as prayed.

7. Costs in the cause.
