RULING

1. Vide the notice of motion dated 1/10/2025, the applicant sought, inter alia, an order directing the Commissioner of Cooperatives to appoint a liquidator in relation to an unnamed organization, to facilitate enforcement of the judgment and decree in Meru ELC Case No. 73 of 2015. When the matter came before court on a certificate of urgency, the court directed the applicant to serve the application and attend court today to address it on the jurisdiction of the Environment and Land Court on the issue of appointment of a liquidator.
2. The applicant has attended court through counsel and has applied to withdraw the suit so that he can pursue enforcement on the platform of the case in which the judgment and decree were issued. The plea has been made at an ex-parte stage.
3. In the absence of any opposition, the oral plea to withdraw the suit is allowed. The suit is marked “withdrawn with no order as to costs.” The file is marked “closed.”
