JUDGMENT

1. For determination is a Notice of Motion dated 26th June 2025 by which the Plaintiff prays for orders as hereunder;-
 1. Spent.
 2. That the Agreement of 28th April, 2022 amounts to an admission of fact of indebtedness, by the Defendant to the Plaintiff as envisaged under Order 13(2) of the Civil Procedure Rules 2010.
 3. That judgement be and is hereby entered against the Defendant on admission for the claimed, and admitted sum of Kshs. Eighty Three Million, One Hundred Thousand (Kshs. 83,100,000/=).
 4. That interest of 46% of Kshs. Eighty Three Million, One Hundred Thousand (Kshs. 83,100,000/= as per clause 4 of the Agreement dated 28th April 2022, from the date of default (28th April 2022) until the date before judgement.
 5. That interest of 12% of Kshs. Eighty Three Million, One Hundred Thousand (Kshs. 83,100,000/=) from the date of judgement until payment in full.
 6. That Costs of this Application and the suit, at 14% interest be awarded to the Plaintiff.



2. The Motion is supported by the Plaintiff's affidavit sworn on the same date of the Application. It is contended that the Defendant admitted indebtedness vide the said Agreement of the parties dated 28th April 2022, without the need to offer proof of the fact.
3. The Plaintiff has filed return of service of the suit documents as well as the Application under consideration. The Defendant has neither entered appearance nor filed defence. The Application is also unopposed.
4. Consequently, Judgement on admission is entered as per prayers 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 of the Application.
