SENTENCE

1. The Appellant was arrested on 25/10/2022.
2. He was sentenced on 3/8/2023 to serve 4 years imprisonment.
3. Though the trial court indicated that it had considered the period spent in remand, it was not indicated how and the eventual effect on the sentence meted.
4. The Appellant prays the period be considered and deducted from the sentence of 4 years imprisonment; and the state concedes to it.
5. From 25/10/2022 to 3/8/2023 we have 9 months and 9 days.
6. Four years less 9 months and 9 days is equal to 3 years, 2 months and 21 days. The sentence is so adjusted.
7. File is closed.
