RULING

1. The present application for review of sentence is not opposed by the respondent. The applicant was charged and convicted of child neglect. I have considered the application, supporting affidavit and the oral submissions by both parties.
2. I have equally considered the Social Inquiry report filed by the probation office. The same is dated 15/10/2025.
3. The applicant is a single parent. It would not be good to keep her away from the two children unless it is very necessary. For their sake the applicant will be placed on Probation for two (2) years. During the said period she should be counselled and assisted to live a respectful social life. She will also relocate to her parents home in Uasin Gishu County. The probation office in Nakuru to direct her to where she will be reporting while in Uasin Gishu.

4. The baby who is the subject of this case (Jayden Kipchirchir) to remain in the custody of the Africa Gospel Church Baby centre in Ngata Nakuru. The management of the said facility knows the procedures to follow in the event of any request for release.
