RULING

1. This file was opened for purposes of considering whether the convict David Aligula Katieso is suitable for consideration of his sentence review in the spirit of prison decongestion pursuant to the Chief Justice Memo dated 7th December 2022.
2. Before the trial court, the applicant was convicted for the offence of indecent act with a child contrary to section 11(1) of the *Sexual Offences Act*, No. 3 of 2006. He was sentenced to serve ten (10) years imprisonment.
3. From the record, the applicant has served six years of the custodial term imposed. I have carefully considered the sentence review report prepared by the probation officer.
4. Having gone through the circumstances precluding the applicant's conviction, it is evident that the offence is so serious, thus, the applicant is not suitable for early release or a non-custodial sentence. In my view, the applicant should serve his sentence to completion both to reinforce rehabilitation and the seriousness of the offence.
5. Accordingly, I find that the applicant is not eligible for early release. The application lacks merit and is hereby dismissed.

Orders accordingly.
