RULING

1. The Respondents were served with the application for leave to apply. They have not responded. I have considered the application dated 16/9/2025 seeking leave of court to file Judicial Review orders for mandamus to compel the Respondent to deliver a Ruling in KPMDC Disciplinary Case No. 69/2022. Wherein the Respondent heard the complaint on 23/1/2024 but todate, the 60 days within which Ruling was to be rendered lapsed over 1¹/₂ years.
2. In my view, the applicant has a prima facie arguable case to be considered the substantive stage. I grant leave to apply and direct the applicant to file and serve the substantive motion forthwith in a separate Judicial Review file, and within 7 days of today, enjoining any Interested Parties in the Disciplinary case. Costs shall be in the main motion.
