RULING

- 1.** The Application that is before the court for determination is the one dated 9th June 2025 where in the Applicant seeks orders to join the Honorable Attorney General as the 4th Respondent.
- 2.** The Application is supported by Seth Ojienda the advocate for the Applicant.
- 3.** It is his case that considering that all the Respondents are agents of the government it will be necessary to add the Attorney General as a party to the suit.

4. The court has considered the principle that set out in the case of in the case of **Trusted Society of Human Rights Alliance v Mumo Matemu & 5 Others [2014] eKLR, SC Petition No. 12 of 2013**, the Supreme Court defined an Interested Party thus in paragraph:

“A person who has a stake in the proceedings, though not a party to the cause. Such a person must demonstrate a personal interest or stake in the matter, must be identifiable, and must demonstrate that the interest is clearly identifiable and proximate enough to stand apart from the interest of the general public.”

5. The Application is unopposed. In the opinion of the court, the Honorable Attorney General is a necessary party to the suit.

Determination:

6. The Application has merit.

Order:

The Application is allowed as prayed.
