**JUDGMENT**

1. By Notice of Motion dated 22<sup>nd</sup> April, 2025, the Applicant craves orders as hereunder;-
  - a. That the court be pleased to order that the Certificate of Taxation issued to the Applicant as against the Respondent be converted into a judgement and decree of this court and consequently, a judgement be entered for the Applicant against the Respondent, for Kshs. 84,350/=.
  - b. That interest does accrue on the sum of Kshs. 84, 350/=, at the rate of 14% per annum, with effect from 15/8/2024 until payment shall be made in full, as prescribed in Paragraph 7 of the Advocates Remuneration Order.
  - c. That the Costs of this Application totaling to Kshs. 50,000/= be awarded to the Advocates/ Applicant and be borne by the respondent.
2. Despite evidence of service of the Application, no reply is filed. The application is therefore deemed as unopposed.
3. A relevant Certificate of Taxation of Costs issued by the Deputy Registrar of the Court is exhibited.
4. The Application is hereby allowed as prayed, and Decree shall issue accordingly.
