RULING

1. The applicant herein was charged before the lower court with the offence of Dealing in Wildlife Trophy without a permit contrary to section 92 (2) of the *akn ke act 2013 47 Wildlife Conservation and Management Act, 2013*. He was sentenced to seven (7) years' imprisonment.
2. She has filed the present undated application seeking sentence review. The averment made in support of the application is that he has undergone sufficient rehabilitation. She urged the court to grant a non-custodial sentence.
3. I have considered the application, the grounds in support, and the applicable law. From the record of the trial court, the court considered the applicant's mitigation, the time spent in remand custody and the fact that the applicant was a first offender before sentencing. Having considered the application in its totality. The sentence imposed was also legal in the circumstances of the case.
4. In my view of the foregoing, I find no good cause or reason to revise the sentence imposed by the trial court. The application dismissed for lacking in merit.
