RULING

1. I do consider the application seeking to stay a money decree.
2. I contend that the Respondent is entitled to the fruits of his judgment and as such a conditional order of stay shall be ideal under the circumstances:
 1. I thus allow a conditional stay of Judgment Decree in CMCC NO.E436/2024 pending hearing of the Appeal.
 2. The Applicant shall pay to the Respondent Kshs.500,000 within the next 45 days.
 3. The Applicant shall set down the Appeal for admission and hearing within next 60 days.
 4. Default on any of the conditions in (2) and (3) above shall automatically vacate the stay order leaving the Respondent with opportunity to execute.

It is so directed.
