**RULING**

3. The court has carefully reviewed previous Rulings, especially of 20/4/2025 by F. Gikonyo – Judge, to ensure a comprehensive understanding of the matter, which should instill confidence in the court's final position.
4. Since no party has appealed the previous Ruling, the court finds the application dated 29/9/2025 untenable and hereby strikes it out without orders as to costs, affirming the finality of the earlier decision.
