RULING

1. By Notice of Motion dated 17th September, 2025 the Applicant seeks orders as here under: -
 1. Spent
 2. Spent
 3. That the Honourable court be pleased to grant anticipatory bail pending the arrest or charge on terms that court may deem fit to impose.
 4. That costs of this application be provided for.
2. The Application is supported by the Applicant's affidavit evidence by which he complains that police officers visited her home on 17th August, 2025 inquiring on her whereabouts in a hostile manner. She had no prior information of the visit and no Summons had been issued requiring her to meet with the officers, hence the Application.
3. The Respondent through prosecution counsel (Mr. Wakasyaka) does not oppose the Application as long as the Applicant will co-operate during police investigations.
4. The Court is not told what investigations are being carried out, if any. The Applicant therefore deserves protection of the court. She is ordered to execute personal bond of Kshs.100, 000 and she will obey lawful any police summons in case of any criminal investigations being conducted.
5. Ruling accordingly.
