RULING

1. The applicant was charged and, after a full trial, convicted for the offence of robbery with violence contrary to section 296(2) of the Penal Code. He was sentenced to death by the trial court. The applicant filed an appeal challenging the conviction and sentence. The appeal was heard and dismissed by this court.
2. In a ruling delivered on 9th June 2025 and 11th November 2025, this court dismissed applications by the applicant for sentence review. In addition, the court directed applicant not file any other application of that nature.
3. The applicant has now filed a fresh application seeking similar orders. The application is an abuse of the court process and is dismissed for lacking in merit.
