**RULING**

1. The chamber summons dated 9/1/2026 seeks leave of this court to apply for Judicial Review orders of mandamus to compel the Respondents to settle decree and certificate of order Against the Government dated 4/11/2025 issued in Milimani HC Misc Civil Appl. No. E095/2024 between Invigorate Strategies Ltd vs The County Government of Bomet.

2. The application though brought under certificate of urgency, is not urgent. I therefore decline to certify it as urgent.
3. On the merits thereof, I observe that the applicant has annexed decree issued in the cited matter on 15/7/2025, certificate of order Against the Government dated 4/11/2025 for a sum of Kshs. 1,712,629.83 and a demand for settlement dated 5/11/2025. It was served on 1/12/2025 which is after 21 days of date of issue.
4. In the premises, I am satisfied that the applicant has an arguable case for consideration at the substantive stage and that it is deserving of the leave sought.
5. I grant leave to the applicant to apply for mandamus compelling settlement of decree and certificate of order against the Government dated 4/11/2025 in the sum of Kshs. 1,712,629.83 issued in Milimani HCCOM Misc Appl. No. E095/2024. The substantive motion to be filed and served upon the Respondents within 21 days of today.

6. This being a Miscellaneous file, the applicant to file the substantive motion in a fresh Judicial Review file. Costs if any, shall be in the main motion.
7. This file is therefore closed.
8. I so order.
