JUDGEMENT

1. For the court's determination is the Applicant's Notice of Motion dated 18th August 2025 for orders as hereunder;-

1. That judgement be entered for the Applicant against the Respondents for the sum of Kenya Shillings Two Hundred and Thirteen Thousand, Nine Hundred and Twenty Two

(Kshs. 213,922/=) in costs certified by the Deputy Registrar on 9th June 2023.

2. That the sum of Kshs. 213,922/= in costs be paid with interest at the rate of 14% per annum from 17th April 2017 being the date one (1) month after the service of the bill of costs on the Respondents, until payment in full pursuant to paragraph 7 of the Advocates (Remuneration) Order, 2009.

3. That the costs of this application be awarded to the Applicant/Advocate.

2. The Application is supported by grounds set out on the body thereof as well as affidavit evidence of Martin Mwaniki Advocate. In a nutshell, the Applicant's Law Firm claims the stated sum on the basis of an Advocate-Client Bill of Costs the Deputy Registrar of this court taxed on 9th June 2023.
