**RULING**

1. This Appeal was placed before the Court on 14th November 2025, on an application filed by the Appellant for stay of execution.
2. The Court directed that the application is served upon the Respondent, and replying affidavit filed, within 7 days of service.
3. Parties were to then obtain a date for hearing of the application at the Registry.
4. Instead of fixing its application for hearing as directed, the Appellant has filed a second application dated 8th February 2026, seeking the same orders of stay of execution.
5. The Appellant states that the initial application has not been assigned a hearing date, without disclosing what steps the Appellant has taken, to be assigned a hearing date.
6. The second application is in abuse of the process of the Court.

It Is Ordered:-

- a. The application dated 8th February 2026 is hereby struck out.
- b. The Appellant shall schedule its application dated 13th November 2025 for hearing.
