IN THE MATTER OF ADOPTION OF MINOR BO ALIAS BP ALIAS EP (THE CHILD)

RULING

1. I am unable to write the judgment herein.
2. None of the reports, on record, give a background of the child sought to be adopted, yet this entire cause is about him. There are no particulars relating to when he was born, his parentage, and the circumstances leading up to his being freed for adoption.
3. There is also the issue of adoption of children by a prospective parent of a different gender. That has not been addressed, to demonstrate how the applicant would fit into any exceptions to that.
4. Let the applicant address those concerns, before the matter can be cleared for judgement. The matter shall be mentioned on 21st April 2026.
