**RULING**

1. Upon hearing the application dated 13/01/2026 and Replying Affidavit of the 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent of 23/01/2026, the Court finds merit in the application for extension of time to comply with orders of the Court for deposit of a Bank Guarantee as security for the appeal.
2. The Court, however, directs that the Bank Guarantee shall be expressed to cover the full decretal sum of Ksh.930,000, together with costs and interest that shall accrue from the decretal sum and costs as stated in order of the Court dated 28/10/2025.
3. The Court extends the period for compliance by a further fourteen (14) days.
4. In default, execution to issue.

Order accordingly.
