**RULING**

1. This Court has considered the summons dated 15<sup>th</sup> October, 2025 together with representation in support of and opposition and I am persuaded to find the application to be of no merit.
2. The Applicant lacks *locus standi* to move this Court.
3. The Orders sought have an effect of disruption of the ongoing distribution without any justification.
4. The Applicant may consider obtaining authority to sue on behalf of his deceased husband and to raise her concerns relating to the 1<sup>st</sup> house directly against the surviving personal representative of the 1<sup>st</sup> house.
5. Mention for progress on distribution in 6 months. Mention on 24<sup>th</sup> September, 2026.
