JUDGMENT

1. The Respondent herein sued the Appellant before the trial court seeking damages arising from a road traffic accident that occurred on or about 5th May 2017 involving motor vehicles KBQ 032E and KBR 425T/ZF 0051, allegedly driven negligently by the Appellant's servant or agent.
2. The trial court held the Appellant 100% liable and awarded a total of Kshs. 207,550 general damages together with costs and interest.
3. Aggrieved by the finding on liability, the Appellant lodged the present appeal, raising five grounds which, in substance, fault the trial court for:
 - i) ***Finding the Appellant 100% liable without sufficient evidential basis;***
 - ii) ***Disregarding police and investigative evidence;***

- iii) ***Failing to analyse the totality of the evidence on record;***
- iv) ***Ignoring corroborative documentary evidence;***
and
- v) ***Failing to consider contributory negligence.***

4. Parties filed written submissions. By consent, Naivasha HCCA No. E040 of 2024 was designated as the lead file on liability, while quantum was not substantially contested in this appeal.
5. This court has already addressed and upheld the trial court's decision on the issue of liability in the lead file being Naivasha HCCA E040/2024 with directions that judgment in the said file shall apply in this case and all the other related cases. I have, in the said judgment, found that the trial court arrived at the correct finding on liability.
6. Accordingly, the trial court's finding of 100% liability is hereby upheld. This means that the instant appeal fails and is hereby dismissed with costs to the Respondent.
