JUDGMENT

Background

1. The claimant filed this instant claim vide the statement of claim dated 6/10/2025 seeking judgment in the sum of Kshs.21,300/=. It is the claimant's averment that the respondent upon request was supplied with 30 bags of Simba 50kgs cement on credit worth Kshs.21,300/= which monies remained unpaid despite numerous demands to do so
2. I have perused the claim and the supporting documents and I have perused the certificate of service filed and I find that the respondent was duly served with the claim.
3. A perusal of the documents filed, I find that on a balance of probabilities the claimant has proved the claim against the respondent.
4. The service of the claim having been proper, the claim having been supported and proved by documents attached to the claim and pursuant to Section 27 of the *SCC Act*, default judgment be and is hereby entered in favour of the claimant as against the respondent for the amount claimed.

Disposition.

5. The claim contained in the statement of claim dated 6th October 2025 is allowed in the sum of Kshs.21,300/= together with costs and interest at court rates.
6. The interest to be calculated from date of filing the claim until payment in full.



7. The file be and is hereby closed.

8. It is so ordered.
