**RULING**

1. The Applicant was convicted on his own plea of guilty for the offence of assault causing actual bodily harm contrary to Section 251 of the *Penal Code*. The trial court sentenced him to serve three (3) years’ imprisonment. The Applicant has served eleven (11) months of his sentence and is remaining with seventeen (17) months after remission, to complete the sentence. The Sentence Review Report filed on 13<sup>th</sup> January 2025 by the Probation Officer Mr. Nelson Maroa recommends a non-custodial sentence. I hereby direct that the Applicant shall serve a Community Service Order at Kebirigo Boys Secondary School under the supervision of the Probation Officer and the school principal for the remainder of his sentence.

Orders accordingly.
