RULING

1. The Applicant was convicted on his own plea of guilty for the offence of assault causing actual bodily harm contrary to Section 251 of the *Penal Code*. The trial court sentenced him to serve eighteen (18) months' imprisonment. The Applicant has served four (4) months and three (3) weeks of his sentence and is remaining with eight (8) months after remission, to complete the sentence. The Sentence Review Report filed on 13th January 2025 by the Probation Officer Mr. Mpaera Lerionka Johnstone recommends a non-custodial sentence. I hereby direct that the Applicant shall serve a Community Service Order at Kiangeni Location Chief's Office under the supervision of the area Chief Mr. Titus Ondieki for the remainder of his sentence.

Orders accordingly.
