RULING

1. The Applicant was convicted of the offence of grievous harm contrary to Section 234 of the [Penal Code](#). The trial court sentenced him to pay a fine of Kshs. 80,000/= or to serve three (3) years imprisonment in default. The Applicant has served fourteen (14) months of his sentence and is remaining with ten (10) months after remission, to complete the sentence. The Sentence Review Report filed on 13th January 2025 by the Probation Officer Mr. Nelson Maroa recommends a non-custodial sentence. I hereby direct that the Applicant shall serve a Community Service Order at Getare Secondary School under the supervision of the Probation Officer and the school principal for the remainder of his sentence.

Orders accordingly.
