RULING

1. The Applicant was convicted on his own plea of guilty for the offence of breaking into a building and committing a felony contrary to Section 306 (a) of the *Penal Code*. The trial court sentenced him to serve one (1) year imprisonment. The Applicant has served three (3) months of his sentence and is remaining with five (5) months after remission, to complete the sentence. The Sentence Review Report filed on 13th January 2025 by the Probation Officer Mr. Mpaera Lerionka Johnstone recommends a non-custodial sentence. I hereby direct that the Applicant shall serve a Community Service Order at Mecheo Chief's Camp under the supervision of the Assistant Chief Mr. Peter Ongoti for the remainder of his sentence.
