RULING

1. The Applicant was convicted of the offence of grievous harm contrary to Section 234 of the [Penal Code](#). The trial court sentenced her to serve five (5) years' imprisonment. The Applicant has served three (3) years of her sentence and is remaining with 4 months after remission, to complete the sentence. The Sentence Review Report filed on 13th January 2025 by the Senior Probation Officer Mr. Nelson Maroa recommends a non-custodial sentence. I hereby direct that the Applicant shall serve a Community Service Order at Kiangoso Sub-location Office under the supervision of the Probation Officer Mr. Nelson Maroa and the Assistant Chief.

Orders accordingly.
