RULING

1. The Applicant was convicted on his own plea of guilty for the offence of shop breaking and committing a felony contrary to Section 306 (a) of the Penal Code as read with Section 279 (a) of the Penal Code. The trial court sentenced him to pay a fine of Twenty Thousand Shillings (Kshs. 20,000/=) or to serve ten (10) months’ imprisonment in default. The Applicant has served three (3) months of his sentence and is remaining with three (3) months, after remission, to complete the sentence. The Sentence Review Report filed on 9th April 2025, by the Probation Officer Mr. Nelson Maroa, recommends a non-custodial sentence. I hereby direct that the Applicant shall serve a Community Service Order for four (4) months at Mwancha Primary School under the supervision of the Probation Officer Nyamira and the School’s Head-teacher.

Orders accordingly.
