RULING

1. The applicant was charged with the offence of creating a disturbance in a manner likely to cause a breach of the peace. The brief facts are on the 4th day of February 2025, at around 0900hrs at Vumilia ‘A’ village, Soy location in Soy sub-county, within Uasin Gishu County, created a disturbance in a manner likely to cause a breach of the peace while armed with two stones to harm Daniel Rugut.
2. The applicant was later pleaded guilty to the offence and subsequently convicted and sentence to 6 months imprisonment. He has approached this court for review of sentence under section 362 & 364 of the CPC.

Decision

3. The record has been examined and I find no evidence of irregularity, impropriety, or illegality on the part of the learned trial magistrate for this court to exercise revisionary jurisdiction. The application is dismissed for want of merit under section 382 of the CPC.
